ESIC Hospital Peenya, Bangalore has successfully performed another oncosurgery

CASE REPORT

A 46 year old female named Mrs Mona Kumari came to our hospital with complaints of vomiting and constipation since 4 months. She is a known case of hypertension on treatment. She was diagnosed to have carcinoma stomach with gastric outlet obstruction. Later the patient was planned to undergo radical gastrectomy by Oncosurgeon Dr Anup, Anaesthetist Dr Jayaprakash S and team under general anaesthesia with thoracic epidural and CVP monitoring. Patient underwent subtotal gastrectomy with D2 lymph node dissection with Roux-enY gastro-jejunostomy and jejuno-jejunostomy. With intraoperative minimal blood loss the surgery was successfully finished. Patient was shifted to intensive care unit for post operative monitoring, wound care and post op analgesia. Post op analgesia achieved through thoracic epidural analgesia with 0.125% bupivacaine with 30 microgram fentanyl.. Post operative totalparenteral nutrition started through CVP line. Patient recovering well.
